- A non-refundable entry fee of \$10.00 per photo will be charged for all entrants who are not members of CVPS. Make check or money order payable to: Conservancy for CVNP.
- A maximum of 3 entries will be accepted per photographer (more than one print may be entered per category).
- The sponsors reserve the right to decline entries if any of the requirements are not met. Prints not properly prepared will not be displayed!

REQUIREMENTS:

- Prints only, framed and ready to hang.
- All prints must be securely wired.
- Black frames with white mats are required for acceptance into the contest.
- Each entry must be packaged with bubble wrap for transportation to Akron.
- Only 1 image and 1 frame per entry.
- <u>Maximum size:</u> 16" x 24", including matting, but excluding frame.
- Minimum size: 12" x 16" with visible print area at least 8" x 10".
- Photographer's name and phone number must appear on the <u>back</u> of each print - not on the front.
- A digital image must accompany every entry. Image must be 1200 pixels on the long side (best to use sRGB color space.)
 Photographer's name and titles of photographs must be printed on CD. Note: CD should contain only show entries with all entries on one CD.

CATEGORIES:

- A Plants/Flowers
- B Animals/Wildlife
- C Landscapes and Activities in the Park
- D Digital Design

*Color and Black & White images are acceptable in all categories

For categories A-C, all images must accurately reflect the subject matter in a realistic way. Digital darkroom techniques may be used so that it still closely resembles the real scene (e.g. minor adjustments to color, contrast, sharpness; cropping; removal of dust spots; realistic use of HDR).

Category D is appropriate for photos that have been altered to achieve an interpretation that departs from realism (e.g. composites; surrealistic HDR; subtraction of subject matter; addition of elements, textures and overlays).

The sponsors reserve the right to:

- a) reclassify an entry deemed to be inappropriate for the category entered
- b) combine categories where there are insufficient entries to judge separately
