Photographers will provide prints of those images selected for exhibit. The Conservancy will pay for framing and matting. Photographers may choose to offer their prints for sale at the Gallery.

Submission deadline is Friday, February 13, 2015. Images to be considered must be submitted as JPEGs to <u>cvpsexhibit@gmail.com</u>.

More specifics:

- Only CVPS members may submit images.
- Images must have been created in conjunction with a Photo Society workshop, photo walk or road trip.
- Up to five images may be submitted by each photographer.
- Images must be submitted by email sent to <u>cvpsexhibit@gmail.com</u>.
- Submission deadline is Friday, February 13, 2015.
- Images must be submitted as JPEGs, no more than 1200 pixels on the longer side, in sRGB color space.
- Metadata for images must include the photographer's name, contact information and the approximate location of the image.
- By submitting, the photographer agrees the work may be displayed to the public online by CVPS.
- Photographers whose work is selected for the gallery exhibit agree to provide a print 14" on its longer side on larger paper suitable for framing.
- The Conservancy will provide matting and framing.
- The Conservancy will collect a 40% gallery fee for any images sold as a result of the exhibit.
- The framed prints that are not sold will be the property of the photographer at the conclusion of the exhibit.
