Landscape and Lightroom: Capture and Process with Tim Cooper Thursday evening, October 20 – Sunday, October 23, 2016 Workshop Fee: \$395 CVPS member/\$460 non-member

Join CVPS for an exciting workshop with professional photographer Tim Cooper to improve both your photographic technique and software skills. With a combination of field and classroom sessions, Tim will guide you through the important concepts for creating meaningful

Tim also will provide an in-depth discussion of Lightroom's Library and Develop modules to help you streamline your import process, make simple but powerful adjustments, create HDR and panorama images and fine-tune your images.

Tim's dynamic teaching style will improve your skills in landscape photography from start to finish.
