

### **Tours and Workshops**

Central Florida Birding Photo Tour Sunday, February 25 – Friday, March 2, 2018 Fee: \$495 for CVPS members

Join Cuyahoga Valley Photographic Society (CVPS) Steering Committee members Jim Roetzel and Steve Ash for a photo tour to some of Florida's best bird photography locations. The tour will capture the rich diversity of Florida, including numerous avian subjects (waders, raptors, ducks, songbirds and shorebirds). While scouting the tour in 2017, Jim and Steve photographed more than 50 species!



During the tour, you also will photograph alligators and take close-ups, habitats and scenics. Taking advantage of the best light the tour will start by exploring a variety of locations near the city of Titusville. From there, you will visit Merritt Island, Vierra and Orlando Wetlands, and two small parks. You will leave Titusville and travel to Lakeland, where Circle B Bar Reserve will be the main focus. Circle B provides a great variety of birds and habitats, so you will spend two full days there before departing for Orlando and the last two locations: Lake Apopka and Gatorland.

### **Instructional Sessions**

The tour will have two pre-trip sessions. The first will be for participants to meet each other, cover trip logistics, and share tips on traveling with photo gear. The second -trip session will build

your bird photography skills, so you can arrive in Florida ready to make the most of your time. After the tour, the group will reconvene to share favorite images.

### **Details and registration**

The tour will begin Sunday, February 25 at 6 p.m. at a motel near Titusville and conclude after dinner on Friday, March 2. You will be staying at three motels during the tour. A block of rooms has been reserved at a discounted price. Participants are responsible for their own lodging, food and transportation costs (car-sharing encouraged). To enjoy group camaraderie, plan to share meals together at local restaurants. Nature Photography with Willard Clay
Thursday, October 25 – Sunday, October 28, 2018

Join one of the masters of landscape photography, Willard Clay, to strengthen your photographic skills and vision. Willard will share his years of experience to help participants gain a deeper understanding of what makes great nature photography and how to incorporate those elements in their own work. He will place special attention on teaching strong composition, as well as understanding and creatively using light. Field sessions will provide the opportunity to apply these ideas and techniques, assisted by Willard. In addition to classroom lectures and field shooting, Willard will provide constructive critique sessions to help participants refine their work and take it to the next level.

### **Workshop Details and Registration**

Participants must be comfortable using their camera equipment and a tripod, understand the basics of photography and be able to download their images for critique. The workshop will meet from Thursday, October 25 at 6:30 p.m. through Sunday, October 28 at 4:00 p.m. Registration will be available beginning in early 2018.


