#### CONTEST RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

## Please read all requirements before submitting your photos.

- Open to current members of Cuyahoga Valley Photographic Society. You must have a
  current membership with the Photo Society. If you are unsure, please check with the
  Conservancy. If you are not currently a member of the photographic society, you may sign up
  at: https://www.conservancyforcvnp.org/join/cuyahoga-valley-photographic-society/
- Photos that have won an award in any category in previous Cuyahoga Valley Photo Society photography contests are ineligible for the 2024 Contest.
- Entries must have been taken within the boundaries of any State, Local or National Park,
  Wildlife Refuge or preserve or National Forest in the United States. Entries in the CVNP
  category must have been taken within the boundaries of the National Park (see
  <a href="https://www.nps.gov/carto/hfc/carto/media/CUVAmap1.pdf">https://www.nps.gov/carto/hfc/carto/media/CUVAmap1.pdf</a>) or the Metro Parks included
  within the National Park boundaries. Photos taken in near by parks (e.g. Viaduct Park or the
  Nature Realm) may be submitted in other categories.
- Up to four entries per photographer will be accepted. More than one photo may be entered per category.
- Entries must be submitted as JPG/JPEG email attachments to <a href="mailto:cvpscontest@gmail.com">cvpscontest@gmail.com</a>, using "CVPS Photo Contest Submission" in the subject line. No entries other than email attachments will be accepted. Please do not embed photos in your email.

• File Requirements: Please review carefully

File Type: JPG/JPEG

**Resolution:** 1920 pixels on the longest side, **Please make sure your photos** have been resized to 1920 pixels on the long side before submitting them.

Digital color space: sRGB

**File Name:** Do not use personally identifiable information in the file name. Use springpeeper.jpg rather than janedoe1.jpg or jd1.jpg.

**Metadata:** Include the photographer's full name in the author field in the metadata.

- All images must reflect the subject matter in a realistic way. Digital darkroom techniques may
  be used to optimize the image so that it still closely resembles the real scene (e.g., minor
  adjustments to color, contrast, sharpness; cropping; removal of dust spots; realistic use of
  HDR; black and white conversion).
- No text should be visible on the image when it is displayed or projected, e.g. no watermarks with the photographer's name or signature.
- Photographs may be taken with any device, including cell phones.
- Black & White/monochrome photos may be submitted in any category.
- Entries received after midnight Sunday, November 3, 2024 will not be considered.

#### **2024 CATEGORIES**

- A. Landscape
- B. Wildlife
- C. Macro/close up smaller subjects (for example, plants, insects, mushrooms) represented as large in the frame.
- D. CVNP Any images taken within the boundaries of the Cuyahoga Valley National Park and adjacent Metroparks (e.g.Brecksville, Bedford).

First place awards will include a \$100 gift card; second place, a \$50 gift card; and third place a \$25 gift card. Additional prizes TBD.

An award including a \$200 gift card will also be presented for the Tim Thomas Best of Show.

- 1. **File Name** (the name of each electronic photo file that you are attaching)

- 3. **Photo Title** (the title of each photo that you would like to use)
- 4. **Location** (approximate location where each photo was taken, e.g., Mentor Marsh SNP, Mentor, Ohio)

- Re-size any images that do not meet the requirements above and change the color space to sRGB. The resulting image may not look as you intended.
- Combine categories where there are insufficient entries.
