

Instructional Photo Tour with Ian Adams April 24-27, 2008

About the Tour:

Participants will drive to the Hocking Hills area on Thursday evening (about 3.5 hours from the Akron area), stay overnight Thursday, Friday and Saturday and return home late morning on Sunday, arriving back in the Akron area in mid-afternoon. Participants are responsible for their own transportation and hotel reservations.

The Hocking Hills provides the most rugged scenery in the Buckeye State, and the emphasis will be on rock scenery, streams and waterfalls, spring wildflowers, ferns, and flowering trees and shrubs. Primary locations for field trips will be Conkel's Hollow, Old Man's Cave, Cedar Falls, Ash Cave, Rock House, Cantwell Cliffs and Zaleski State Forest. Participants should be capable of hiking on hilly trails.

The field sessions will be supplemented by classroom sessions on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings. Topics might include:

- Slide program on the Hocking Hills area (part of orientation on Thursday evening);
- Digital workflow, using Adobe Photoshop CS3 and Adobe Lightroom;
- Sharing your digital photographs in slide programs and color inkjet prints;
- Building and maintaining a photography website;
- Marketing and publishing your photography.

Participants are encouraged to bring laptop computers with Photoshop, Photoshop Elements or Lightroom installed so that they can browse and edit their digital photographs during the photo tour. A high-resolution digital projector will be available to facilitate the classroom sessions and, in the event of bad weather, conduct a review/critique of photos.

Ian is an environmental photographer based in Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio, specializing in natural, rural, historical and garden photography. Since 1985, more than 4,500 of his color photographs have been published in books, posters, calendars, magazines and other publications. Over the past 15 years Ian has conducted more than 130 nature and garden photography seminars and workshops.
