Workshop Schedule

The workshop meets **Friday-Sunday, February 17-19** from **9:00am-6:00pm** each day at the Boston Store Visitor Center in Cuyahoga Valley National Park:

There will be a lunch break each day, during which participants may visit a restaurant or eat a bag lunch that they bring with them. CVPS will provide coffee/tea and snacks for participants to enjoy throughout the workshop.

Tim is also offering a free public lecture on Thursday evening, February 16, 7:00-9:00pm at Happy Days Lodge in Cuyahoga Valley National Park, located at 500 West Streetsboro Road (SR 303), Peninsula 44264. While this presentation is not an official part of the workshop, we encourage all participants to attend if they are available. Tim will be sharing his beautiful photography and instructing about light and landscape photography. The description of his presentation is below. Admission is free and guests are welcome.

Magic Light - a Landscape Photographer's Join professional landscape Passion. photographer Tim Cooper for an information packed evening on landscape photography. Tim will explain how he captures his dramatic photographs during the Magic Light hours of early morning and late evening. clarify qualities of light, define the twilights surround that sunrise and sunset, demonstrate filters to help capture this tricky light, plus share tons of tricks and compositional tips to help your outdoor photographs move from snapshots to pieces of art!

What to Bring

All participants must bring:

- A laptop (or desktop if you want to carry it and set it up).
- All necessary cables and power cords.
- Your computer must be loaded with the most recent complete version of Adobe Lightroom software (the latest complete version of is "3"; version 4 is still in Beta form).
- Photographs to work on. If they are on an external drive, make sure to bring that with you.
- Note-taking materials and questions!
- Please help our sustainability efforts by bringing your own mug for coffee/tea.
- This is a classroom-based workshop; you may want to bring a sweater or sweatshirt to be comfortable in the building.

While field shoots are not part of this workshop, local CVPS members are a wealth of knowledge

about where to photograph in Cuyahoga Valley National Park and would be happy to suggest locations to those interested in photographing in the park. Therefore, those coming from out of town may want to bring their camera gear and tripod.

Tim now spends most of his time as an educator lecturing on photographic and digital imaging technologies throughout the country. He is currently on the faculty of the Rocky Mountain School of Photography, leading field and digital workshops, and is the author of several books on Photoshop as well as training videos for photographers. His free online photo club, PhotoCircle is a place where he shares his knowledge and passion for photography by hosting a Q&A section, posting tutorials, and recording photographic critiques.
