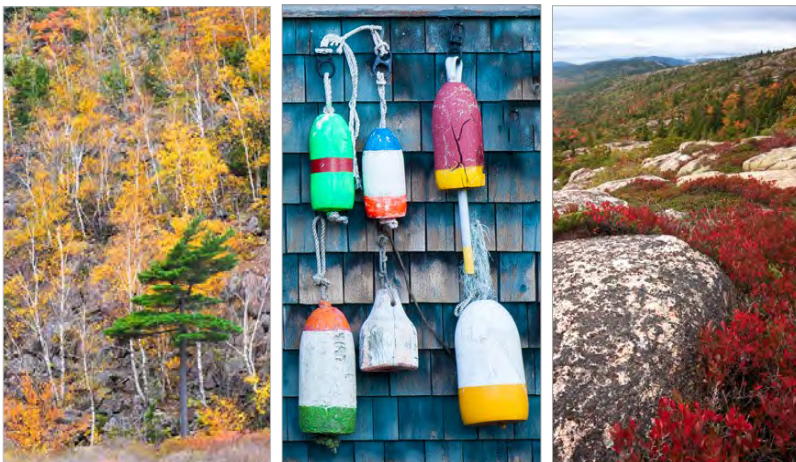
Shooting Locations

We'll take advantage of the best light to explore Acadia's beautiful rocky coastlines, fishing harbors, inland ponds, and autumn forests. Our list of shooting locations includes: the Park Loop Road, Cadillac Mountain, Bass Harbor Lighthouse, Otter Cliffs, Jordan Pond, Wild Gardens and Sieur De Monts. We'll also have opportunities to photograph macro, fishing boats, and New England architectural details in the town of Bar Harbor.



Instructional Sessions

In addition to field shoots, the trip will include daily classroom sessions in which the leaders will cover topics such as improving landscape and fall color photography, digital workflow tips, and critiques of images taken by group members. Participants should be experienced photographers who are comfortable with their camera, tripod, and managing their images. Participants are encouraged to bring a laptop to download and process images for critique.



Tour Details

Our tour will begin Sunday, October 11 at 6pm and conclude at 3pm Thursday, October 15. The Bar Harbor Motel is the home-base; a block of rooms has been reserved at a discounted price (\$89+tax/nt). Participants are responsible for their own lodging, food, and transportation costs (we encourage car-sharing). To enjoy the group camaraderie, we plan to share meals together at local restaurants.
